Sheffield Towers

Sheffield Towers are apartment units located at 100 Superior Avenue, Aliquippa, PA 15001. Operated by Beaver County Housing authority, the units are located right off of Sheffield Avenue and directly behind the Aliquippa Police Station on Franklin Avenue.

Funding from Behavioral Health Unit of Beaver County and collaboration between Gateway Rehabilitation Center and Adult Probation Department will assist individuals who need safe and structured housing. Sheffield Towers will be a step up unit for individuals who are stable mentally and chemically.

Individuals considered for these units will be screened by a committee to support "step-up criteria".

Welcome

The purpose of the Sheffield Towers Housing Program is providing you with safe, structured environment through housing. In addition, Gateway will have a variety of clinical staff: therapist, Supplemental Services staff, and peer specialist available to connect, direct and inform you of services and supports available for you in the community.

The program is funded by the Beaver County Behavioral Health unit and is a joint collaboration with Gateway, APO and Beaver County Housing Authority.

Within a three block radius of this facility is a wide variety of services that can assist you. They are as listed: Job training, GED training, 12 Step Meetings, a coffee shop, churches, a library, etc.

A schedule of known meetings is included in your handbook. This schedule will be reviewed and will be posted in the lobby daily. In addition to outside supports, on site programming will be provided and listed on the schedule. These programs and supports will help you in your transitioning.

As stated, a staff member will be on hand daily to assist you and help monitor your progress.

Program Overview

Gateway Rehabilitation Center will provide individual/group support for Sheffield Tower residents needing assistance transitioning into the community.

Gateway staff will be on site to provide life and leisure activities for residents living in the building. These activities will include:

- ❖ Aerobics / exercise for diverse population in this setting
- ❖ Other activities suited for this unit and identified by its residents.

Activities will be planned for the community room located on the second floor.

Games and activities will be located on site for resident usage.
